Notes

- The referee will oversee all disputes.
- All disputes must be placed in writing and handed to the Event Convenor within 30 minutes of the race concluding. All disputes will be deliberated upon by the GISSA committee. GISSA committee consists of one representative from each school. The committees' decision is final.
- Two start rule applies for track events; any runner who starts before the starting signal will be given one warning and then disqualified on the second occasion.

Program

- Each school enters athletes in the following age groups: 13yr, 14yr, 15yr, 16yr and 20yr for boys & girls.
- Age Eligibility: age as at 31 December in the year of competition. For example, in 2022, to be eligible for 15-year age group students must be turning 15 in the calendar year. In other words, born in 2007.
- Refer to the Team registration document for number of competitors for each event.
- Events; 100m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 4x100m, Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump, Triple Jump & High Jump
- Note: Individuals can compete in 5 events and a relay.

School Scoring

The school with the highest aggregate will be awarded the perpetual shield. A 'Points Trophy' will also be awarded to the winning school, based on student population.
